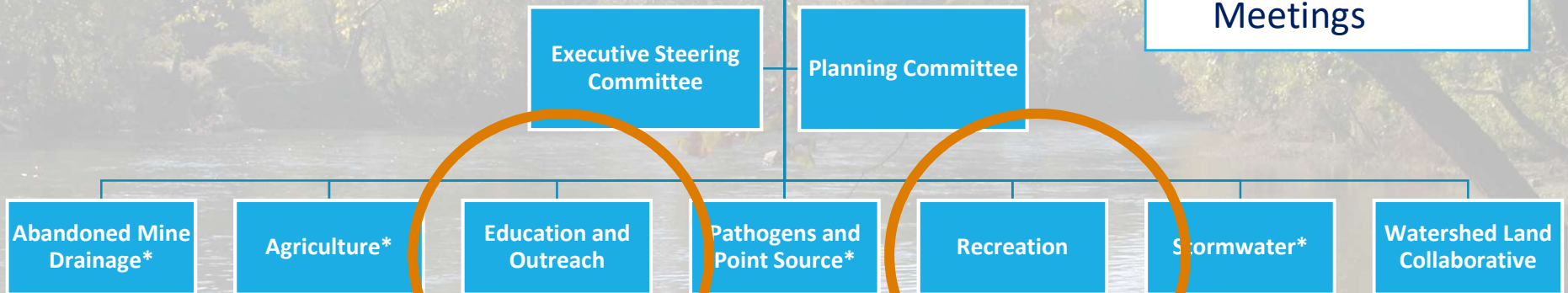
How we adapted in 2021

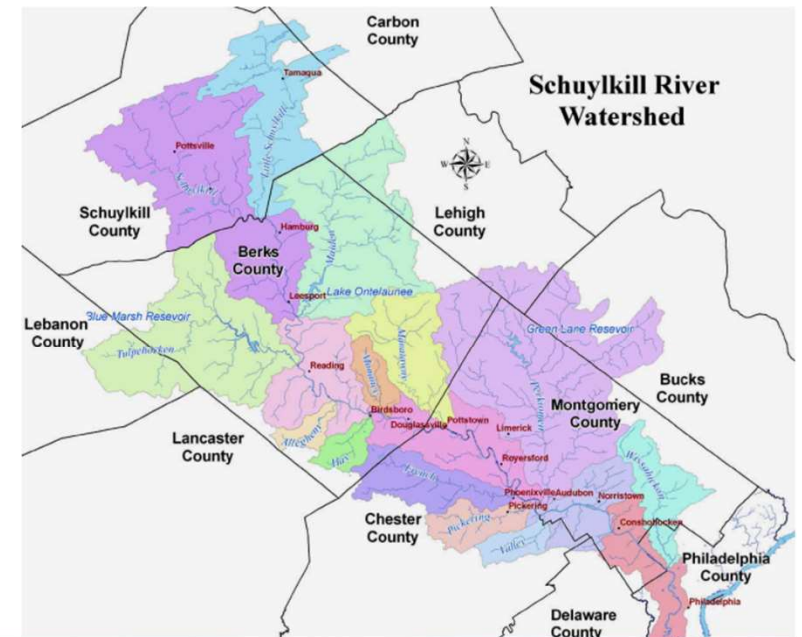
