- 3. Aligning Conservation Interests in the Schuylkill watershed (10:15 10:45) All
 - a. How is the Watershed Land Collaborative unique and different from existing land conservation groups
 - i. It is watershed-wide, though it needs more participation from partners in different areas of the Schuylkill watershed. SAN brings a network approach that models the value of group collaboration that this group is looking to incorporate, particularly with federal, state and local agencies
 - ii. This group was brought together to support and discuss landowner outreach which is an essential first step to landscape protection.
 - iii. This group is founded on the basis that land preservation is an integral component of protection for water quality, esp. drinking water
 - b. The core interests of the land collaborative workgroup partners are:
 - i. Identify data-sharing opportunities and challenges
 - ii. The group was interested in emulate g the Kittatiny Risge program approach involving a shared smart sheet that could track accomplishments, challenges and instances of contact with landowners in areas where Trust geographies overlap
 - iii. Addressing the major challenge of need for pre-transaction funding

- Pre-transaction funding is a critical first step for land preservation projects

 - 2. Level/acceleration of land preservation

 - 1. Heritage Conservancy
 - Pennsylvania Department of Conservation and Natural Resources (DCNR)
- e. The group considered "how do we use existing tools and what are the benefits of alignment?"
 - Each organization presents its own prioritization score card for land acquisitions
 - 1. There could be an upcoming workgroup meeting where they align/compare them
